All questions regarding this Request for Proposals must be submitted prior to October 5, 2011.

The following questions and answers are provided for additional information and clarification:

1. Do you need 24x7 chairs? [We are not anticipating purchasing chairs at this time.](#)
2. How many screens will be on each console? What size are the screens? Do the screens need articulation or will they be stationary and not required to move or be adjusted by an Operator? [Consoles should be able to accommodate 19-inch screens. The monitor's position must be adjustable by the operator.](#)
3. What other equipment needs to be accommodated on the consoles and what are their quantities? i.e. keyboards, phones, lights, radios, CPUs, foot pedals. [Two \(2\) keyboards, two \(2\) CPUs, one \(1\) "push to talk" microphone on console and one \(1\) foot pedal at each position.](#)
4. There are (3) "traditional" Dispatch Console designs; the first is an oval shaped stand alone workstation, the second is a "serpentine" design of standalone workstations configured so adjacent console touch at the sides, and the third is an office cubicle design with Operators and their equipment focused towards the corner of the cubicle. Which design does the City of Lompoc require? [Though not required, we would be interested in the serpentine and oval sit-to-stand designs.](#)
5. Do the Operators require the ability to see around the room? Is there any particular AV System that needs to be seen? [Yes, there will be a large surveillance system with monitor on the wall.](#)

6. Is the room on a raised floor? How will cabling reach the consoles? **The floor is raised. Cabling will be through the floor.**
7. Does the sit-to-stand system require memory? **This is unknown at this time.**
8. What size desk drawer is preferred? **We currently have a rolling cabinet at each station with a 12x12 inch drawer and two drawers half that size above.**
9. When would the City of Lompoc like to have the consoles delivered and assembled? We would like the consoles delivered as soon as possible. **We currently plan to use City-forces to install the consoles, however, we would like to have each proposer include their costs for installation. The installation of the new consoles will be coordinated with the installation of the new radio equipment.**
10. What is the timeline for the project? **See question #9 above.**
11. Viking currently does not have a business tax license for the City of Lompoc, Is a proposer required to obtain a City of Lompoc Business Tax License? **A business license is not required to submit a proposal. If the City elects to use your company to install the furniture, a business license may be required. This can be purchased after you are awarded the bid.**
12. Page 3-4 under evaluation criteria, part of the evaluation process lists financial stability of proposer(d) and experience of staff(e), I see nowhere in the bid where it requests that information, are we to supply that information? Company **financial information is not required to be submitted with the proposal.**
13. How many CPU's per station? Monitors? Sizes? **Three (3) monitors, two (2) CPUs and one (1) UPS at each station**
14. Is the room on the ground floor? **The Dispatch Center is located on the ground floor.**
15. Does the building have a loading dock? **The building does not have a loading dock.**
16. Would there be a need to replace the radio dispatch system in the future? **Replacement of the radio system is not a part of this solicitation.**
17. Our furniture raises and lowers to the heights specified in 3.a. with a single keyboard/monitor surface. The monitors move on independent arms. Is this system acceptable? **Yes**
18. We do not provide keyboard tilt as specified in 3.a. because it limits keyboard/mouse space. Is this acceptable? **Yes**
19. Are laminate panel dividers mandatory if our furniture system does not use them as part of the structure? **No**

20. Due to the technical nature of our furniture, it must be installed by factory authorized installers to validate the warranty. Is this acceptable? [Yes](#)

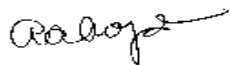

1. **GENERAL.** The selected vendor shall furnish all materials listed in the proposal specifications. In order to receive full consideration, proposals must fully follow these specifications.

2. **PROJECT.** The City of Lompoc Police Department Communications Center is located at 107 Civic Center Plaza, Lompoc CA 93436. It is the intent of the City to purchase new dispatch consoles for this site as specified in the Minimum Specifications.

3. **WORK CONSOLES.** Console furniture must be designed specifically for a 24/7 operations in an Emergency Communications Center environment.
 - a. Ability to raise and lower monitor surface separate from the keyboard surface. All movement to be push button. Work surface range shall be at minimum 27" – 42". Tilt capability on keyboard surface.

 - b. Ability to work in a standing or seated position.

 - c. Have CPU's placed in a cabinet with doors that open rather than panels that need to be removed to access them. Also have CPU's placed on sliders so they can be pulled out for easy access to front and back of unit.

 - d. Clean cable management system.

 - e. Two (2) desk drawers to hold supplies per console.

 - f. Laminate panel dividers (or City accepted alternate hard surface panels). Color to be determined after bid closing.

 - g. Furniture must include cable management solution.

 - h. Items should include, as a minimum, a three (3) year all inclusive replacement warranty with purchase.

 - i. Laminate work surfaces. Color to be determined after bid closing.

2. **SUBMITTALS REQUIRED WITH BID.** City requires one drawing showing complete floor plan with the proposed consoles and one drawing showing one typical console in 3D view.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **ISSUANCE OF BID:** This bid request creates no obligation on the part of the City and the City reserves the unconditional right, at its option, to either reject all proposals or waive any irregularities or informalities therein.
2. **BID SUBMISSION:** Proposals must be mailed or delivered in sealed envelope and must be labeled with the ***Name of Bidder, Bid Title, and Date and Time of Opening***. Prices shall be printed or typewritten. Mistakes may be crossed out and corrections printed adjacent and initialed by person signing the bid. Bidders must complete and return the Exceptions to Specifications page of the specification page(s) in order to be considered.
3. **MORE THAN ONE BID:** More than one bid is allowed.
4. **BID VALIDITY/WITHDRAWAL:** Prices shall remain valid for ninety (90) days from date of opening and be inclusive. Proposals submitted may be withdrawn by written request received BEFORE the hour set for opening. No bidder may withdraw their bid after the time set for opening.

6. **MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS:** When applicable, bidders shall conform to California Labor Code, Section 6360 and Title 8 CAC, Section 339 and 5194 and submit MSDS on hazardous substances with bid.
7. **LOWEST APPARENT BIDDER SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:** The lowest apparent bidder may be required to submit the following:

8. **QUANTITY ADJUSTMENT:** When applicable, it is mutually accepted that the quantities defined in this document reflect the approximate City requirements and may be adjusted. City may require and order or reorder more than the quantity listed here by mutual agreement with the prevailing vendor.
9. **COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS:** All proposals shall comply with current federal, state and local laws relative thereto, including applicable Federal and State Occupation Safety and Health laws and that Seller will indemnify and hold the Buyer harmless for any failure to so conform.
10. **CONTRACT LIMITATIONS:** Any resulting contract shall be limited to all terms and conditions herein, including any general and special conditions and instructions, purchase order or other documents issued by the City.
11. **NEW/UNUSED AND LATEST MODEL:** Bidders shall provide pricing on new and unused items, material and/or units specified unless otherwise stated in specifications.
12. **WARRANTIES:** Bidder will fully warrant all materials and equipment for a period of not less than one (1) year from date of final acceptance by the City unless otherwise noted. All warranties, standard and extended, shall be shown on any units offered, and all costs related to the servicing of said warranties shall be clearly stated on bid form.
13. **F.O.B. POINT AND SHIPPING CHARGES:** All prices shall be quoted F.O.B. destination Lompoc, California. Any and all shipping, handling and freight charges shall be shown separately and included in the bid unless otherwise noted on bid form. If there are no shipping or handling charges itemized they are assumed to be included in the base price offer and no charges will be paid separately.
14. **CANCELLATION:** Any agreement resulting from an award may be canceled by either party at any time upon thirty (30) days written notice. The City may cancel any agreement WITH CAUSE within ten (10) days written notice to supplier.
15. **LAWS GOVERNING CONTRACT:** The contract shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of California and the County of Santa Barbara is the only appropriate forum for any litigation. In the event a suit or action is instituted arising out of any contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to receive, in addition to its cost, such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as to attorney's fees and costs.
16. **TAXES (FEDERAL EXCISE/SALES OR USE/LOCAL PREFERENCE):** The City is exempt from Federal Excise Tax. All taxes, if applicable, shall be shown on bid form page. ALL TAXES; Sales, Use and Local Preference will be a consideration in bid evaluation.

17. **MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES:** It is the policy of the City that minority business enterprises shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in the City's bidding requirements.

18. **EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY:** It is the policy of the City to promote the full realization of equal employment opportunity.

20. **SELL OR ASSIGN:** Contractor shall not have the right to sell, assign or transfer any obligations resulting from the award without the specific written consent of the Purchasing and Materials Manager.

21. **REASONS FOR AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION OF PROPOSALS:**

a. Failure of bidder to fulfill all basic requirements will result in automatic bid rejection. A Letter of Bid Disqualification is sent to bidder failing to meet any of the requirements. The checklist of reasons for rejection as follows:

b. Failure to sign bid document.

c. Failure to ensure bid was received by City of Lompoc Purchasing Offices on or before bid opening date and time and the address specified in the bid.

d. Failure to provide bid security (if required and in the form and amount specified).

e. Failure to attend mandatory bidders' conference or mandatory site inspection.

f. Failure to initial price alterations for one or more items.

g. Failure to provide information or other supplemental materials as specified in the RFP or bid.

h. Failure to bid on all items when specifically required.

i. These items are self-explanatory and are applied equally and irrevocably to all vendors and their proposals. Therefore, bidders must be conscientious in fulfilling all requirements in order to have their proposals considered for award.

22. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT** Any Agreement resulting from this Bid will consist of the following documents, in order of precedence, and shall be the entire agreement between parties:

24. Solicitations opening at 3:00 p.m. PDT will be considered late at 03:00:01 p.m. PDT and will not be accepted or considered. The Purchasing and Materials Manager Agent or his representative designated as the bid opening official shall decide when the time set for bid opening has arrived, and so shall declare to those present. Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud.

ATTACHMENT "A"
City of Lompoc
INDEMNITY AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS
(Example)

The City of Lompoc requires that you furnish and maintain current certificates of insurance for the duration and term of that contract within the scope and limits of the Indemnity and Insurance Requirements listed here. The certificates and endorsements are to be signed by a person authorized by the insurers to bind coverage on their behalf.

You must secure the following insurance coverage to protect the City from claims brought against the City, employees, authorized representatives, agents, or third parties.

1. **Worker's Compensation Insurance** **in an amount not less than \$1,000,000** per occurrence as required by State of California statutes, and employer's liability insurance (including disease coverage). Insurer shall waive all rights of subrogation against the City, its employees, representatives, and agents.

2. **Automobile Liability Insurance** with coverage for any vehicle including those owned, leased, rented, or borrowed. This insurance shall have an endorsement naming the City as Additional Insured and with a standard cross-liability clause or endorsement. The limit amount for this insurance shall be not less than **\$500,000** per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage.

3. **General Liability Insurance** including ^{a.} premises and operations, products, completed operations, contractual liability, independent contractors, and broad form property damage coverages. This insurance shall be on a ^{b.} commercial insurance, occurrence form with an endorsement naming the City as Additional Insured and with a standard cross-liability clause or endorsement. The limit amount for this insurance shall be **not less than \$1,000,000** per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage.

4. **You must provide a separate endorsement naming the City as an additional insured** referencing your name

and policy number. Examples of such endorsements are ISO CG 25 04 11 85, ISO CG 25 03 11 85, ISO CG 25 01 11 85.

5. The insurance policies described above shall include the following provisions or have added by endorsement:

a. The **coverages shall be primary**, and no other insurance or self-insurance such as may be utilized by the City shall contribute to a loss under these policies.

b. The policies shall not be canceled or materially altered without **30 days prior written notice** to the City.

6. The insurers utilized shall conform to the following terms:

a. Insurers shall have at least an **"A-"** **policyholder's rating** and a **"VII" financial rating** in accordance with the most current **Best's Key Rating Guide**.

b. Vendor shall furnish the City, within ten (10) calendar days of receiving Notice of Award, or a Request for Insurance letter, and not less than two (2) working days prior to the commencement of the work, with adequate certificates of insurance and with original endorsements affecting coverage as will demonstrate that the provisions and/or requirements of this section have been complied with.
